Certificate of Insurance

All exhibitors are required to submit a completed ST-19 form and certificate of insurance. See the following pages for forms and information. Completed forms must be submitted to events@activecentralmn.org.

Exhibitor agrees to forward a certificate of insurance with a 30-day notice of cancellation provision, noting all details noted in this paragraph, to the holder ("Active Central MN"). Exhibitor shall at all times during the term of its event agreement with Active Central MN for the CentraCare Earth Day Run, maintain general public liability insurance written by a recognized insurance company against all claims for bodily injury, death or property damage which occurs out of or in connection with the activities contemplated by the Health & Fitness Festival booth registration agreement with:

- Limits of not less than \$1,000,000 combined single limit on an occurrence basis, and Not less than \$2,000,000 general aggregate and products.
- Active Central MN shall be listed on such insurance policy as an additional insured for the term
 of this agreement.
- Exhibitor shall upon execution of this agreement and prior to the event provide to Active Central MN a certificate from the insurance company certifying Active Central MN as an additional insured.
- If you do not have an insurance policy, there are special event policies that can be obtained. If
 you need assistance with this, please inquire with an insurance agent and their small business
 unit.
